The following communications from the VAAA are brought to your notice:

"Amateur Status"

The Council of the IAAF draws attention to amendments made to Eligibility Rule 53, Paragraphs 7,8 and 9 now reading:

- (vii) receives, directly or indirectly, any compensation for using or recommending the use of any merchandise whatsoever; "Merchandise" shall include anything sold or any service supplied to the public.
- (viii) allows his name or his picture, whether static or moving, to be used directly or indirectly to advertise any merchandise.
Note: When and where it is proved that the name or the picture of the athlete was used for the purpose of this paragraph without his knowledge, the indemnity to be collected from the person or persons responsible for the injury, privately agreed upon or stipulated by the Courts, will revert to the Federation to which the athlete belongs.
- (ix) while training or competing, displays any advertisement whatsoever.

It will be noted that para.(ix) precludes, among other things, the carrying into the arena of any bag or container bearing the name of any merchandise whatsoever. "Merchandise" includes anything sold or any service supplied to the public. The carrying into the arena of bags displaying the name of makers of running shoes falls within the prohibited category.

JAPAN OPEN MARATHON CHAMPIONSHIP, FUKUOKA CITY, 3.12.1967

The AAU of A is in receipt of an invitation from the Japanese AAF to send our outstanding runner. The sponsors will pay: (1) Return Airfare (Economy Class) between Australia & Japan; (2) Accommodation expenses for 14 days; (3) IAAF daily allowance of \$US 2.00 per day; (4) Interpreter charges and sightseeing expenses during stay in Japan. They are not prepared to meet the costs of a manager.

It is expected that Australia's selected representative will be named subsequent to the Australian Championship on 9.9.1967.

We have hired DOLOMORE OVAL for that Sunday afternoon and it is now up to every VMC member to make the meeting a success. Enquire of your own club whether it has been invited or if it would like to ask for an invitation, a letter to the Secretary of the VMC by SEPTEMBER 30th., accompanied by the appropriate fees will be sufficient.

Trophies will be given to each member of the winning teams, as well as to the first three placegetters in the individual events. Each team must PROVIDE AN OFFICIAL to be allocated on the day and runners in the 1 Hour Run also must provide a person to assist with the scoring. All VMC members not competing are urged to make it their business to attend and assist in helping to build this meeting into a first-rate attraction. In view of the possibilities of a host of State and National Records, we want to give the competitors every chance to succeed.

Your Committee took the following decisions on August 18th. last:

1. The 6 VMC members financial on the day to receive \$7.50 towards their subsidy for expenses incurred to represent the VAAA at the Australian Championships. (Out of 6 team members & 3 emergencies).
2. VMC Certificates to be issued to all members completing VMC Marathon races. Non-members may receive same on payment of 30c.
3. The Secretary to move for the adoption of metric standard events for all scheduled competition of the VAAA, in line with interstate and international practice.
4. The Secretary to move for an Australian wide fixture pattern to avoid congestion of major long distance events.
