As a matter of saving time and facilitating smoother organisation it was recommended that a system be instituted by which members have the option to pay in bulk for the entries listed on the winter program. This sum is to be \$3.00 and at the end of the winter season subscribers may present claims for refunds on those races which they were unable to participate in.

It was also recommended that a subscription of \$25.00 be made to the Australian Harrier for its continued excellent service to distance running in Australia.

The Treasurer reported an exceedingly healthy financial state of club funds and a paid up membership of 127.

Members are reminded that on March 31st. they cease to be financial members of the VMC until the subscription of \$1.00 (50 cents for Juniors) for the 1968/9 season has been received.

Where perpetual trophies are presented to the winner, the recipient will be photographed with the trophy and a suitable print given to the holder. The print is to be endorsed by the signature of two members of the VMC Executive.

The age limit for the determination of the term "Veteran" shall be 40 years on the day of competition or such age as the VAAA may determine from time to time.

- 2. VMC ENTRIES must be in no later than 30 minutes prior to the advertised times for listed events, which will commence sharp on time.
- \* Entry fees are 40c. (surcharge of 10c. for use of host club facilities.
- \* Membership dues are 1 dollar for Seniors and 50c. for Juniors.
- \* Only members financial on the day of competition are eligible for trophy orders.
- \* Trophy orders will go to the first three placegetters in the handicap section, to the fastest time runner in every event, sharing \$15.00 approx.

Selected events will also include a prize for the first Veteran (over 40) and possibly greater prize money for the major placings, depending on the participation of members.

All members may wear a plain VMC club badge (50c.). Those who have completed a Marathon in 3:30:00 or better may add a star, those who have been inside 2:50:00 may add two stars, members having broken the 2:30:00 limit are entitled to wear the VMC badge with Laurel Wreath (60c.). Stars shall be of white material, have five points and must not exceed the diameter of a 5c.piece. They are to be attached below the letters on the badge.

There is likely to be an increasing number of travellers from interstate as well as VMC members going away.

If you can accommodate one or more people, please inform the Secretary and let yourself be put on the list. You are <u>not</u> obliged to take anyone any time but when convenient to yourself.

If you intend going interstate and wish to stay with athletic minded people, notice of your intention can be passed on through your secretary.
